## Description

A concentrated, liquid chlorine releasing bleach with effective stain removing properties. Disperses quickly in water to prevent damage to fabrics. Penetrates to remove stubborn stains. Should not be used on colored fabrics or used on delicate fabrics. For use with automatic dispensing equipment. Do not store near or use with any acid products.

#### **Directions**

Sort laundry by fabric type and soil load. Pre soak if necessary.

This product is to be injected during the wash cycle or to a separate bleach cycle. If using an automated dispensing system, place the dispenser feed tube into the product container. Ideal pH of bleach cycle should be between 10.5-11.0 and the water temperature above 140°F. Use 3-4 ounces per 50 pounds of linen. Be sure that linens are thoroughly rinsed to remove any residual bleach. Refer to MSDS for proper Personal Protective Equipment when using this product.
