



Liquid Laundry Emulsifier (L-31)

Description

This product is a liquid emulsifier and bleach alternative for automated dispensing systems. Its an excellent addition to standard laundry detergent for better stain removal. It contains a blend of surfactants, solvents, and brighteners that are very affective in removing greasy, oily soils such as butter stains, salad dressings, make-up, collars/cuffs, and shop towels.

Directions

Sort laundry by fabric type and soil load. Pre soak if necessary.

This product is to be injected during the wash cycle or directly after. If using an automated dispensing system, place the dispenser feed tube into the product container. Continue by selecting the correct operating program. After selecting your program the dispenser will then automatically inject the correct amount of product during the cycle.
