

Delimer/Descaler (W-19)



Description

Ahoy removes lime, scale, milkstone, film, and light rust from: aluminum, stainless steel, porcelain, glass, etc. This product should be used to clean: dishwashers, steam tables, kettles, utensils, equipment, fixtures, faucets and shower heads, etc. Wear gloves when handling.

Directions

This products main use is for dish machines. When using to descale a dish machine follow the provided dish machine instructions, as the instructions are different per dispenser. (Provided by SPSI). We recommend using 1/3 to a half gallon per drain tank.

When applying to other applications, apply directly to surface (Per spray bottle). Test a small area before applying directly. Allow to penetrate surface for 1 minute. Rinse thoroughly after deliming. Refer to MSDS for proper Personal Protective Equipment when using this product.
